



Sales start for two pre-war projects in Berlin

David Borck Immobiliengesellschaft is marketing 15 residential and six commercial units in Berlin-Friedenau and 14 pre-war apartments and three commercial units in Berlin-Charlottenburg

The renowned Berlin-based brokerage house from managing directors Caren Rothmann and David Borck launched marketing campaigns for 29 residential and 9 commercial units in two pre-war buildings at the end of July. The two historic buildings are located on Charlottenburg's Pestalozzistrasse and at Isoldestrasse 1 in Berlin-Friedenau, two outstanding addresses in the heart of Berlin's City West district.

There are six commercial and 15 residential units available in the Isolde 1 project, with the latter ranging from single apartments to family apartments, all of which are perfectly suited to both owner-occupiers and buy-to-let investors. The 2- to 5-room apartments feature floor plans of between 57 and 156 square meters, with the commercial units offering from 36 to 126 square meters of space. All units boast classic style elements such as high ceilings, parquet or plank flooring, and large windows. Each apartment has a balcony and a windowed bathroom. Buyers with vision can also choose the 420-square-meter rooftop unit and fit it out according to their wishes. Above all, the location in tranquil Friedenau is popular for its numerous cultural and dining options. Nearby, Volkspark Wilmersdorf and Rüdesheimer Platz offer greenery and tranquility, along with a great selection of cafés, restaurants and stores. In addition, Schloßstraße and Kurfürstendamm, two of Berlin's major shopping dstinations, are only ten minutes away.

Close to the fashionable Savignyplatz, another 17 units in a classic Berlin apartment building are available at Pestalozzistaße 98. These attractive units are also being marketed exclusively by the David Borck Immobiliengesellschaft team and include three commercial units of 75 and 110 square meters, plus 14 one- to four-room apartments of between 55 and 144 square meters. The building also has an unfinished unit with 287 square meters of living space. Thus, Pestalozzi 98 also offers the perfect mix of living space for singles, couples and families looking for a new home, or for investors.
